Parent Duty Service Agreement

Introduction

Welcome to San Diego Tamil Palli (SDTP)! This program ensures that every family contributes to the smooth operation and success of our school.

Purpose

The Parent Duty Service Program is designed to:

- 1. Strengthen the partnership between parents and the school.

Parent Duty Service Requirements

- 1. **Service Hours**: Each family is required to complete 8 hours of duty service per academic year.

Documentation and Reporting

- Service Tracking: Parents are responsible for tracking their own service hours. A log sheet will be provided, and you will be required to sign in and out when performing your duties.
- 2. **Verification**: The Parent Duty Coordinator will review and verify service hours. In case of discrepancies or issues, you will be contacted to resolve them.

3. **Completion**: At the end of the academic year, a summary of completed service hours shall be requested by respective families.

Volunteering Beyond Requirements

While the minimum requirement is 8 hours per year, we encourage parents to volunteer beyond this to further support our school community. Additional hours are always appreciated and valued.
